Regulations for the ASTEL Next-Gen Scholarship

1. ASTEL scholarships are established to promote excellence in education and leadership within the New Zealand African community
2. The scholarship will be known as ASTEL Next-Gen Scholarship available to domestic students of African descent who are citizens or permanent resident of New Zealand.
3. The consideration for this scholarship will be based on academic ability and participation in community activities.
4. Applicants will only be contacted if their applications have become successful.
5. The ASTEL Next-Gen Scholarship cannot be held concurrently with another ASTEL scholarship award unless by a waiver.
6. The decisions on the number of awards, the value of the award and the selection of recipients will be at the sole discretion of the Trust.
7. The Trust may choose to act on the recommendation of a panel tasked to review the submitted applications.
8. The recipient must be in full-time study by the time payment is made.
9. The scholarship will be paid as lump sum into a nominated bank account of the recipient upon acceptance and signing of an agreement.
10. The names and pictures of scholarship recipients (ASTEL scholars) may be used in promotional materials to highlight the work of ASTEL.
11. ASTEL is not obliged to give out these awards if there are no candidates with sufficient merit.
